5. Stay here (Repetitive statement)

Acceptance - New

1. Look at what you've done! (blame for persisting, not my vibe chief)
2. Fighting a never ending cycle. Don't you see that? (Rhetorical questioning)
3. Remain on this path and you'll lose everything. (last gambit before break)
4. Iris. Please, stop. (break)
5. Stay away (torn)
